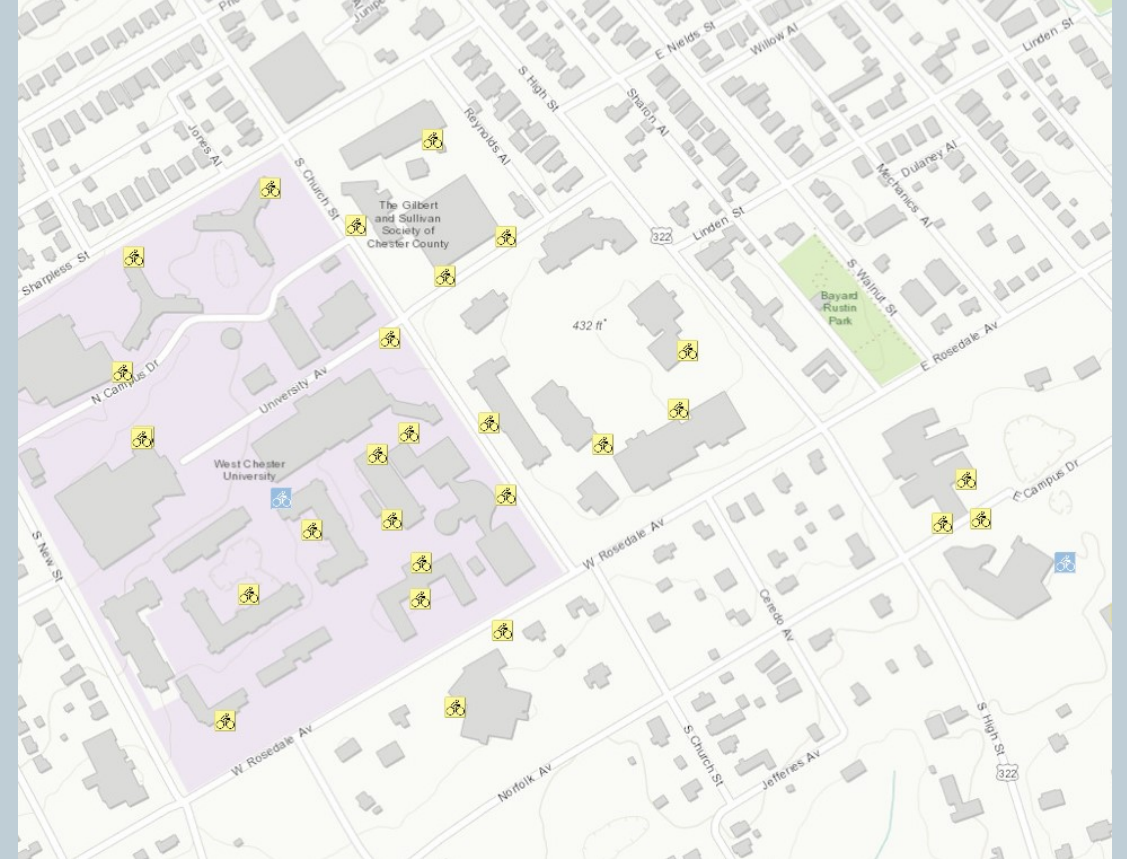

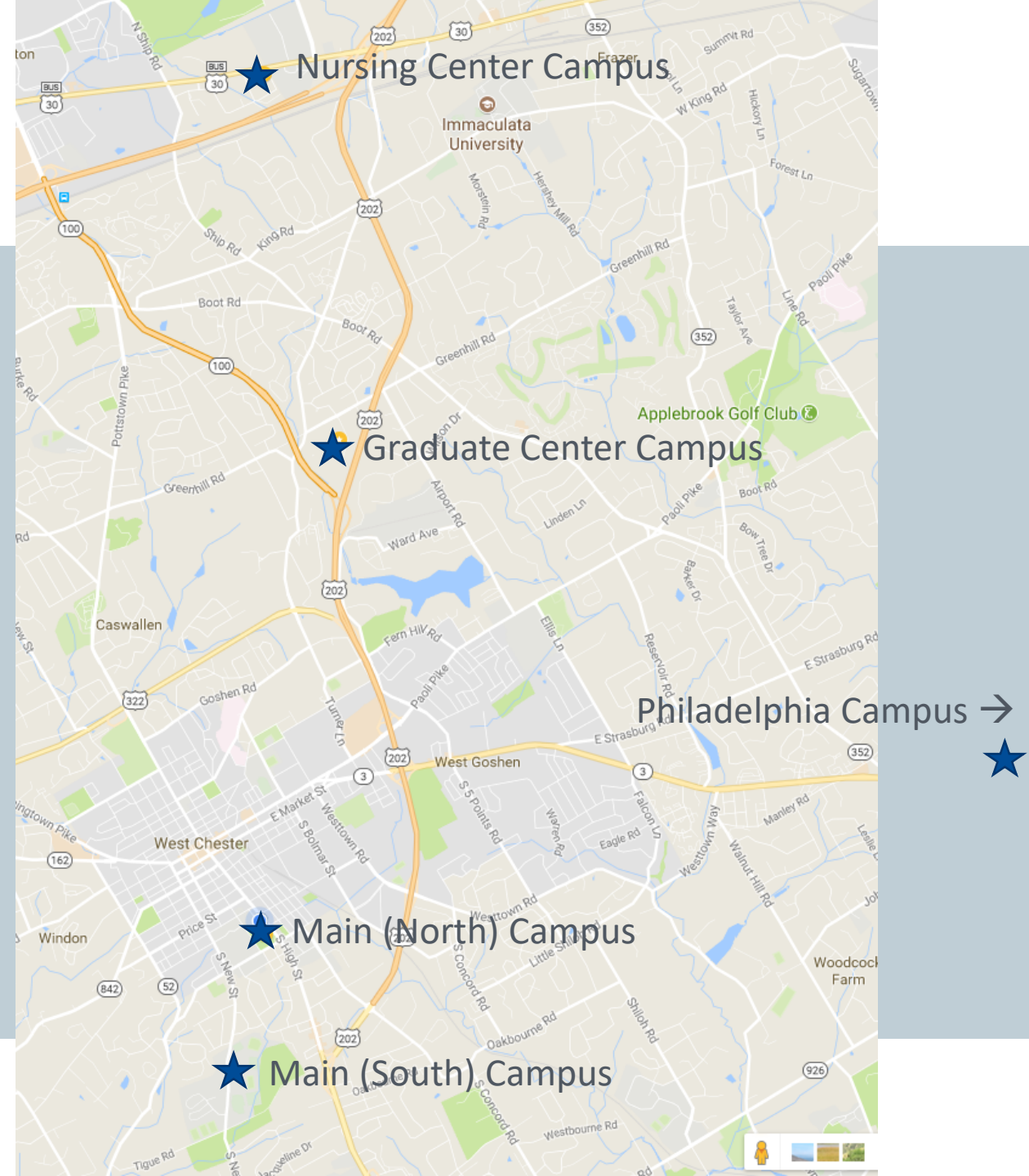

West Chester University

- A public, regional, comprehensive institution
- Undergraduate, post-baccalaureate, and graduate programs
- Largest of 14 PASSHE universities
- Main campus in West Chester Borough, West Goshen Township, East Bradford Township, and Westtown Township



West Chester University's Community

Fall 2016

- 12,800 full-time undergrads
- 900 full-time graduate students
- 3,300 part-time undergrad / grads

17,000 total students

- About 700 full-time faculty; 250 part-time faculty
- About 750 full-time non-instructional staff

1,700 employees

2011 survey

- Employees / Faculty
 - 88% drive
 - 9% walk
 - 2% bus
 - 1% bicycle

2016

- Students
 - 36% live on campus
 - 64% commute or live off campus

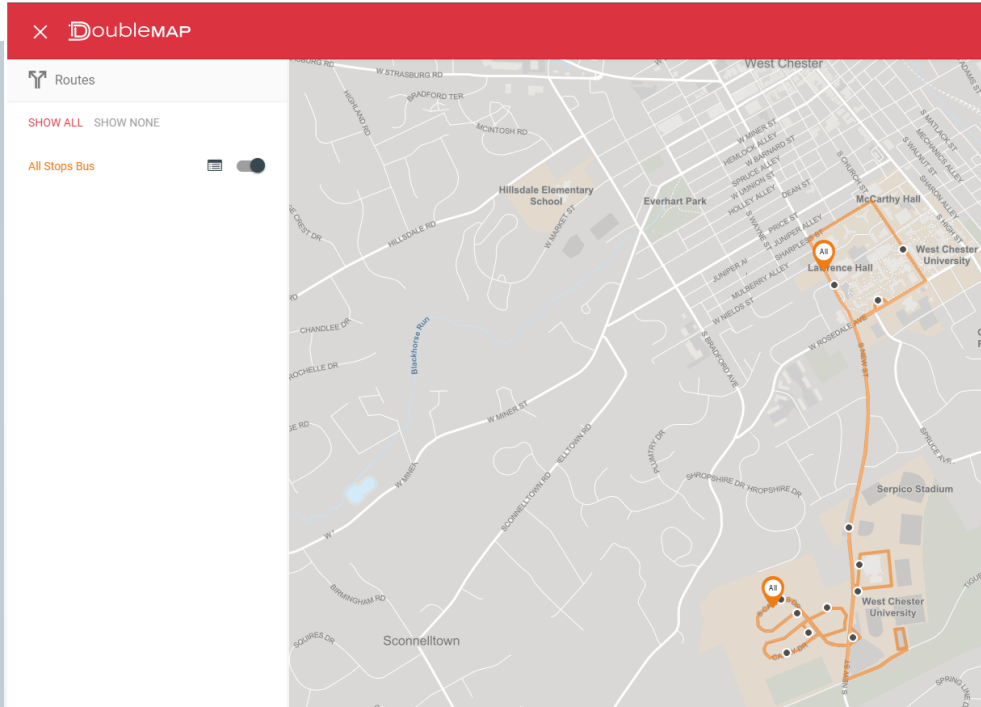
Parking Spaces

- North Campus: 3,347 spaces
- South Campus: 2,026 spaces
- TOTAL: 5,373 spaces

- Includes New St and Sharpless St garages
- Plus, on-street parking

The challenge

- May 2018 closure of Lot D
 - Approx 250 parking spots in desirable, central location on campus
 - Represents about 7.5% of North Campus Parking
4.7% of North + South Campus Parking
 - Changes to circulation patterns
 - Church Street closure?
- Commons Building and Garage
 - Completion in 2020

- WCU Strategic Transportation and Parking Task Force
- WCU Climate Action Plan / Strategic Plan
- Technology:
 - Ridehailing apps (shuttles)
 - Ridesharing apps (parking)
 - Dockless bicycle share programs (bicycling)
- Parking pricing policy
- Investments in bicycle & pedestrian infrastructure / coordination
- Review and reinvention of SEPTA's bus and rail networks
- Coordination with municipalities / county / TMA / region
