PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Westminster Place was built on a former brownfield site that had been the location of a manufacturing plant. This fourstory, 72-apartment building is a mixed-use development with the potential for more than 3,000 square feet of commercial space on the first floor. The community is professionally managed by Presbyterian Senior Living, which provides on-site supportive service coordination for residents. The supportive services team assists with things such as identifying benefits they may qualify for, filling out applications for food and prescription benefits, planning social events, and programming health and wellness activities.
